Brief Summary in Lay Language

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Brief Summary in Scientific Language

The study aims to find out differences and similarities in the internet use and sexual behavior of patients with psychiatric disorders. Secondly we try to find links between our findings and the diagnosis of the patients. Therefore 300 patients will be interviewed regarding their use of the internet, their sexuality and sexual functions. Since the internet use among patients with psychiatric disorders has already been researched (Kalckreuth et al. 2014), we will compare our findings with those of the earlier study.

Our study does not interfere with the therapy of the patients and will only include those, who are not in an acute stage of mental illness.
